

In the Autumn of 2007 I was granted permission to fell twelve mature Beech trees ranging in height from 50-70 ft. The trees were close to my property (photos) and posed a danger in the event of a severe storm or gale. I also required a 25ft. Leylandii hedge (photo) to be replaced by Laurel, the felling of two Norwegian Maple trees and removal of several dead trees including two Scots Pine and a Horse-Chestnut.

I sought quotes from several landscape contractors and accepted the quote from A&B Landscapes.

Whilst space for the felling of trees was not a problem their proximity to my property was of concern. The felling operation gave me no cause for concern, the specialist tree surgeon being brought in at the appropriate time. Removal of unwanted wood and stump grinding was carried out expeditiously and A&B also helped in advising on selection of suitable Laurel plants and the five Hornbeams which were to replace the Beech. I was grateful that available plants were collected and planted with speed and efficiency.

I am grateful to A&B Landscapes for the excellent way they carried out the work and would not hesitate to recommend them for similar work.

Since that time I have employed A&B to carry out a Crown reduction and thinning of a 50ft. Ash tree situated in a small development of semi-detached and terraced properties with access restricted to be through a garage. The boughs extended over four gardens, the tree being located about 30ft. from two of the properties.

My primary concern was that work should be carried out safely and the debris should be cleared quickly, such that neighbours were not unnecessarily inconvenienced.

The job was carried out very efficiently and my neighbours were more than happy with the clearing up operation
